TOUR TALKS OFFERED AT CREATIVE ARTS WORKSHOP

New Haven, CT – In conjunction with the exhibition, “Geographies,” by the New England Guild of Book Workers, faculty from Creative Arts Workshop will offer two tour talks about the 26 interpretations New England, the theme of the show.

The first talk will be Friday October 2nd from noon to 1pm, given by Gisela Noack. The second will be Wednesday October 14th from 5 to 6pm, given by Paulette Rosen. The tour talks are free and open to the public on the first floor of the Hilles Gallery of CAW, located at 80 Audubon Street in New Haven. “Geographies is a book show of both artists’ books and fine bindings,” explains Rosen, also CAW’s Book Arts Department Head. “Come to the talk for a rare opportunity to see the books up close. We will take books out of the display cases and talk about the structure, content and the bookbinders’ intentions.”
